The optional verses are provided when the Acclamation is also used following the Renewal of Baptismal Promises during the sprinkling with blessed water. Where that is the case one way of performing the piece would be for the Acclamation *Springs of Water* to be sung first, then the verses sung continuously with a repeat of the whole Acclamation at the end.
