Come, child<u>ren</u> and hear me that I may teach you the fear <u>of</u> the Lord. Who is he who <u>longs</u> for life and many days, to enjoy <u>his</u> prosperity? Then keep your <u>tongue</u> from evil and your lips from speak<u>ing</u> deceit. Turn aside from evil <u>and</u> do good; seek and strive <u>aft</u>er peace.

The Lord turns his face against the wicked to destroy their remembrance <u>from</u> the earth. The Lord turns his eyes <u>to</u> the just and his ears to <u>their</u> appeal.



Psalm 30 (31): 1-6, 8


In you, O Lord, I take refuge. Let me never be put to shame. In your justice, set me free, hear me and speedily rescue me.




