he téaches his wáy to the poor.

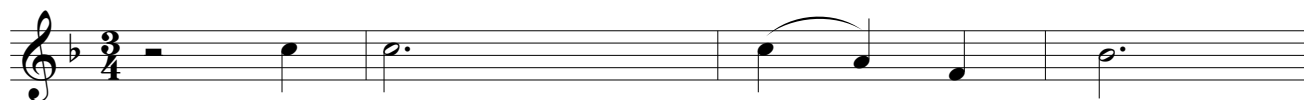

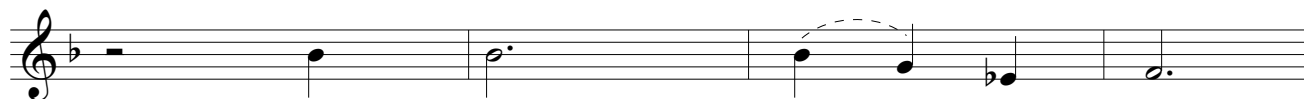
