Psalm 102



- The Lord is compassion and love, slow to anger and <u>rich</u> in mercy. He does not treat us according <u>to</u> our sins nor repay us according <u>to</u> our faults.
- 2. As a father has compassion <u>on</u> his sons, the Lord has pity on <u>those</u> who fear him; for he knows of what <u>we</u> are made, he remembers that <u>we</u> are dust.
- 3. As for man, his days <u>are</u> like grass; he flowers like the flower <u>of</u> the field; the wind blows and <u>he</u> is gone and his place never sees <u>him</u> again.
- But the love of the Lord is <u>ev</u>erlasting upon those who hold <u>him</u> in fear; his justice reaches out to <u>child</u>ren's children when they keep his cove<u>nant</u> in truth.
