

So he brought out his people with joy, his chosen ones with shouts of rejoicing.


And he gave them the land of the nations. They took the fruit of other men's toil, that thus they might keep his precepts, that thus they might observe his laws.



He grants the desires of those who fear him, he hears their cry and he saves them. The Lord protects all who love him; but the wicked he will utterly destroy


Let me speak the praise of the <u>Lord</u>, † let all mankind bless his ho<u>ly</u> name for ever, for ages <u>un</u>ending.
